Example 1: Repetition due to substandard grade (55042): Scenario 1				
Attempt	Grade/ Symbol	Notation	Apport. Eligibility?	Rel. T5 Section
1	F	Student takes class for the 1st time, gets an "F"	Yes yes	55042
2	B	Repeats class due to "F" grade - 1st Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, gets "B" --No more repetitions allowed, unless under a separate provision

Example 2: Repetition due to substandard grade (55042): Scenario 2				
Attempt	Grade/ Symbol	Notation	Apport. Eligibility?	Rel. T5 Section
1	F	Student takes class for the 1st time, gets an "F"	Yes yes yes	55042 55042
2	D	Repeats class due to "F" grade - 1st Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, gets "D"		
3	D	Repeats class due to "D" grade - 2nd Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, gets "D" --No more repetitions allowed, unless under a separate provision

Example 3: Repetition due to substandard grade (55042) Combined With Rep. Due to Extenuating Circumstances (55045)				
Attempt	Grade	Notation	Apport. Eligibility?	Rel. T5 Section
1	F	Student takes class for the 1st time, gets an "F"	Yes yes yes Yes yes	55042 55042 55045 55045 55045
2	D	Repeats class due to "F" grade - 1st Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, gets "D"		
3	C	Repeats class due to "D" grade - 2nd Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, gets "C" <i>Student Petitions for Repetition Due to "Extenuating Circumstances" - Petition is approved</i>		
4	B	Student Repeats class for 3rd repeat, gets a "B" <i>Student Petitions again for Repetition Due to "Extenuating Circumstances" - Petition is approved</i>		
5	A	Student Repeats class for 4th repeat, gets an "A" --No more repetitions allowed, unless due to "Significant Lapse of Time"

Example 4: Repetition due to Significant Lapse of Time (55043)				
Attempt	Grade	Notation	Apport. Eligibility?	Rel. TS Section
1	A	Student takes class for the 1st time, but it was 5 years ago, got an "A"	Yes	55043
2	A	District permits/requires repetition "due to a Significant Lapse of Time" and has established a 3-year recency prerequisite for this course Repeats class due to "Significant Lapse of Time" - per 58161(f) only one repetition on this basis permitted, gets "A" -No more repetitions allowed under this provision	yes

Example 5: Repetition due to substandard grade (55042) Combined With "W" Withdrawals (55024): Scenario 1				
Attempt	Grade/Symbol	Notation	Apport. Eligibility?	Rel. TS Section
1	W	Student takes class for the 1st time, withdraws and receives a "W"	Yes	55024
2	F	Student Re-enrolls in class, gets "F"	yes	55042
3	D	Student Repeats class due to "F" grade - 1st Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, gets "D"	yes	55042
4	W	Student Repeats class due to "D" grade - 2nd Repeat to alleviate substandard grade, Withdraws and receives a "W" -No more repetitions allowed, unless under a separate provision Unused "Ws" are rendered moot since course repetition rules prevent further enrollments	yes	55024

Example 6: Repetition due to substandard grade (55042) Combined With "W" Withdrawals (55024): Scenario 2				
Attempt	Grade/Symbol	Notation	Apport. Eligibility?	Rel. TS Section
1	W	Student takes class for the 1st time, withdraws "at will" and receives a "W"	Yes	55024
2	W	Student takes class for the 2nd time, withdraws "at will" and receives a "W"	Yes	55024
3	W	Student takes class for the 3rd time, withdraws "at will" and receives a "W"	Yes	55024
4	W	Student takes class for the 4th time, withdraws "at will" and receives a "W" Dist. Policy permits additional enrollments and "discretionary" withdrawals with a "W" that are ineligible for Apportionment	Yes	55024
5	W	Student Re-enrolls in class for 5th enrollment, files petition for "W" due to ext. circumstances - Petition approved	No	55024
6	F	Re-enrolls in class for 6th enrollment, files petition for another "W" due to ext. circumstances, but is denied, Gets "F"	yes	55042
7	D	Repeats class due to "F" grade - 1st alleviation Repeat, gets "D"	yes	55042
8	C	Repeats class due to "D" grade - 2nd alleviation Repeat, gets "C" -No more repetitions allowed, unless under a separate provision -Student fully utilized "at will" withdrawals that result in a "W"	yes	55024
